


The Persistent Widow:

Luke 18:6-8 NLT



Reason for the Parable


Encourage Disciples To...

The parable stresses the importance of persistent prayers and remaining faithful even in difficult circumstances!

Points to Ponder

¹I waited patiently for the Lord to help me, and he turned to me and heard my cry



Why Persistent Prayer?



Pray Until Something Happens!

Matthew 7:7-11 NLT

⁷ "Keep on asking, and you will receive what you ask for. Keep on seeking, and you will find. Keep on knocking, and the door will be opened to you. ⁸ For everyone who asks, receives. Everyone who seeks, finds. And to everyone who knocks, the door will be opened.

⁹ "You parents—if your children ask for a loaf of bread, do you give them a stone instead? ¹⁰ Or if they ask for a fish, do you give them a snake? Of course not! ¹¹ So if you sinful people know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give good gifts to those who ask him.

God has a perfect plan for your life.

There will be tough days, you will get tired. But trust His ways and His perfect timing. Your blessings are coming. And while you are waiting, know that your prayers can make a big difference.


