


Trials of Jesus – 3 Jewish & 3 Roman

The Physical Suffering Associated with Crucifixion – Matthew 27:24-31 KJV

- ²⁴ When Pilate saw that he could prevail nothing, but that rather a tumult (noise, uproar), was made, he took water, and washed his hands before the multitude, saying, I am innocent of the blood of this just person: see ye to it.
- $|^{25}$ Then answered all the people, and said, His blood be on us, and on our children.
- ²⁶ Then released he Barabbas unto them: and when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered him to be crucified.
- ²⁷ Then the soldiers of the governor took Jesus into the common hall, and gathered unto him the whole band of soldiers.
- ²⁸ And they stripped him, and put on him a scarlet robe. (Mark 15:17 purple)
- ²⁹ And when they had platted a crown of thorns, they put it upon his head, and a reed in his right hand: and they bowed the knee before him, and mocked him, saying, Hail, King of the Jews!
- ³⁰And they spit upon him, and took the reed, and smote him on the head.
- ³¹ And after that they had mocked him, they took the robe off from him, and put his own raiment on him, and led him away to crucify him.

- -Crucifixion was the most horrible manner of death known to mankind. It was utterly despised by the Jews
- Deuteronomy 21:22-23 KJV
- ²² And if a man have committed a sin worthy of death, and he be to be put to death, and thou hang him on a tree:


²³ His body shall not remain all night upon the tree, but thou shalt in any wise bury him that day; (for he that is hanged is accursed of God;) that thy land be not defiled, which the LORD thy God giveth thee for an inheritance.



The Physical Suffering Associated with Crucifixion

John 19:1 KJV
"Then Pilate therefore took
Jesus, and scourged him."

• Scourged – Flog (Whipped)



THE JEWISH LAW

- Deuteronomy 25:1-3 KJV
- 1 If there be a controversy between men, and they come unto judgment, that the judges may judge them; then they shall justify the righteous, and condemn the wicked.
- ²And it shall be, if the wicked man be worthy to be beaten, that the judge shall cause him to lie down, and to be beaten before his face, according to his fault, by a certain number.
- ³ Forty stripes he may give him, and not exceed: lest, if he should exceed, and beat him above these with many stripes, then thy brother should seem vile unto thee.



PAUL'S LETTER TO THE CORINTHIANS

•2 Corinthians 11:24 KJV

• "Of the Jews five times received I forty stripes save one."

- ²⁴ But Thomas, one of the twelve, called Didymus, was not with them when Jesus came.
- ²⁵ The other disciples therefore said unto him, We have seen the LORD. But he said unto them, Except I shall see in his hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into his side, I will not believe.
- ²⁶ And after eight days again his disciples were within, and Thomas with them: then came Jesus, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and said, Peace be unto you.
- ²⁷ Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing.

- ²⁹ Jesus saith unto him, Thomas, because thou hast seen me, thou hast believed: blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have believed.







TAU CROSS

• The tau cross is a T-shaped cross, sometimes with all three ends of the cross expanded. It is called a "tau cross" because it is shaped like the Greek letter tau, which in its upper-case form has the same appearance as the Latin letter T.



Greek Cross

A Greek cross is popular for eastern Christian churches. The four equal arms represent the four Gospels and the four directions of the compass, to which Church extends. The famous international Red Cross symbols is in the shape of a Greek cross.


And when they were come to the place, which is called Calvary (Latin Name), there they crucified him, and the malefactors, one on the right hand, and the other on the left.

³⁴ Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.















²⁷ And with him they crucify two thieves; the one on his right hand, and the other on his left.


²⁸ And the scripture was fulfilled, which saith, And he was numbered with the transgressors.

³⁰ Save thyself, and come down from the cross.

31 Likewise also the chief priests mocking said among themselves with the scribes, He saved others; himself he cannot save.

³² Let Christ the King of Israel descend now from the cross, that we may see and believe. And they that were crucified with him reviled him.




1st 3 HOURS IN SCRIPTURE

"They gave him vinegar to drink mingled with gall: and when he had tasted thereof, he would not drink."


The pain of crucifixion was excruciating, especially the driving of nails through the victim's wrists and feet. The nails would crush through the median nerve, which runs from the elbow to the hand

"And it was about the sixth hour, and there was a darkness over all the earth until the ninth hour."




2ND 3 HOUR IN SCRIPTURE – John 19:28-30 KJV

³⁰ When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, It is finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.




2ND 3 HOUR IN SCRIPTURE – Mark 15:34-37 KJV

³⁵And some of them that stood by, when they heard it, said, Behold, he calleth Elias.



2ND 3 HOUR IN SCRIPTURE – LUKE 23:46 KJV


⁴⁶ And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit: and having said thus, he gave up the ghost.

Separation from God was a deeper wound upon the Son of God than any punishment man could inflict




2ND 3 HOUR IN SCRIPTURE – REVELATION 12:9-11 KJV
